

**ORDINANCE NO. 3 of 2016**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH AMENDING SECTIONS  
131-22, 131-24, 131-25, 131-29, AND 131-35 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2002**

WHEREAS, the Borough previously adopted Ordinance 1 of 2002, which regulates traffic and parking in the Borough;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update certain provisions of the ordinance as herein after stated to reflect certain changes and update outdated penalties and fines;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Plymouth Borough Council that Ordinance No.1 of 2002 that the Articles and sections listed below shall be amended as follows:

Article IV On-Street Metered Parking

§ 131-22 Parking Meter Zones are hereby Established.

A. Parking meter zones are hereby established on the following streets of the Borough of Plymouth except for such spaces within such parking meter zones where parking is now or shall be hereinafter prohibited:

- (1) W. Main St. from Girard Ave. (Both Sides)
- (2) East Side of Hanover St. from Main St. South along side of  
The Happy Pizza Building
- (3) Main St. from Hanover St. in front of the Happy Pizza Building  
(40 West Main St.)
- (4) E. Main St.(East Side) from Center Ave. to Dan Flood Apartments
- (5) E. Main St.(West Side) from Center Ave. to Bull Run

§ 131-24 Hours and Days of Operation

After the installation of said parking meters, it shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle or other vehicle to park such vehicle for a longer period than the maximum time indicated on the dial of said parking meters between the hours of 9:00 AM and 6:00 PM, prevailing time, Monday through Friday inclusive and any of the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and Seasonal Shopping periods which the Chief of Police may designate.

#### § 131-25 Duration of Lawful Parking Periods

When any vehicle shall be parked in any space adjacent to which a parking meter is located in accordance with the provisions of this article, the operator thereof shall, upon entering such parking space during the time of limited parking, immediately deposit a coin or combination of coins of the United States in such parking meter and operate the same according to the instructions thereon. Failure to do so shall constitute a violation of this Article. Each twenty-five cents (a quarter) deposited, will allow thirty (30) minutes of parking up to a maximum of two (2) hours. Any vehicle parked in a space during the times specified in § 131-24 above, in which the meter shows that the parking time has expired shall be in violation of the Article and subject to the penalties and fines specified in this ordinance. It is noted that council from time to time by resolution can alter the charge and duration to park. Also, it is noted that there is no fee to park a motor vehicle in a Borough Municipal Parking lot.

#### § 131-29 Violations and Penalties

Any person violating any provision of this Article, except for § 131-28, shall for each and every violation, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty (\$20.00) dollars and all filing fees and costs associated with the prosecution of such a violation(s). Failure to timely pay any fines, filing fees or costs in a timely manner shall pay a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and all filing fees and costs associated with the prosecution and in default thereof undergo imprisonment for not more than 10 days.

Any provisions of Ordinance No. 1 of 2002 and any prior amendments to the aforesaid ordinance that are in conflict with the above are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective as provide for in § 3301.3 (b) of the Borough Code.

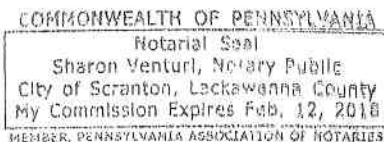

ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2002:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC  
AND PARKING IN THE BOROUGH OF  
PLYMOUTH.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH, UNDER  
THE AUTHORITY OF COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

SECTION 131 . GENERAL RULE

THE PROVISION OF THIS ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DRIVING, PARKING,  
MOVEMENT AND RESTRICTIONS OF VEHICLES, PEDALCYCLES AND PEDESTRIANS  
APPLY TO THE HIGHWAYS AND STREETS, AND TO OTHER LOCATIONS SPECIFIED  
HEREIN, WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH

- B. SUCH TEMPORARY AND EMERGENCY REGULATIONS SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE MAYOR AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE SAME MANNER AS PERMANENT REGULATIONS. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL OPERATE OR PARK A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR IN VIOLATION OF ANY SUCH REGULATION, OR WHO SHALL MOVE, REMOVE, DESTROY, INJURE OR DEFACE ANY SIGN OR MARKING ERECTED, POSTED OR MADE TO GIVE NOTICE OF ANY SUCH REGULATION, SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE LIABLE TO THE PENALTY SET FORTH IN THE LAW OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS CHAPTER FOR A VIOLATION OF SUCH NATURE, AND IN CASE OF A COALITION FOR WHICH NO SPECIFIC PENALTY IS SET FORTH IN THE LAW OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS CHAPTER, TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TEN (\$10.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-4. EXPERIMENTAL REGULATIONS

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL MAY, FROM TIME TO TIME, DESIGNATE PLACES UPON AND ALONG THE HIGHWAYS IN THE BOROUGH WHERE, FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN NINETY (90) DAYS, SPECIFIC TRAFFIC AND/OR PARKING REGULATIONS, PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS SHALL BE IN FORCE AND EFFECT, AND SHALL DESIGNATE SUCH LOCATIONS BY PROPER SIGNS AND MARKINGS. SUCH REGULATIONS, PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS SHALL BE EFFECTIVE JUST AS IF THEY HAD BEEN SPECIFIED IN THIS CHAPTER. NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE OR PARK A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR IN VIOLATION OF ANY SUCH REGULATION, PROHIBITION OR RESTRICTION AND NO PERSON SHALL MOVE, REMOVE, DESTROY OR DEFACE ANY SIGN OR MARKING ERECTED, POSTED OR MADE BY AUTHORITY OF THIS SECTION. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE LIABLE TO THE PENALTY SET FORTH IN THE LAW OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS CHAPTER FOR A VIOLATION OF SUCH NATURE, AND IN CASE OF A VIOLATION FOR WHICH NO SPECIFIC PENALTY IS SET FORTH IN THE LAW OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS CHAPTER, TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAT TEN (\$10.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAT FIVE (5) DAYS. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION IS TO ALLOW FOR THE TEST AND EXPERIMENTAL DETERMINATION OF THE FEASIBILITY AND

DESIRABILITY OF PERMANENT CHANGES IN THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH RELATIVE TO TRAFFIC AND PARKING. ALL EXPERIMENTAL REGULATION MAY BE IMPOSED BY A RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL.

§ 131-5 AUTHORITY OF PEACE OFFICERS.

THE PEACE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH ARE HEREBY GIVEN AUTHORITY TO DIRECT TRAFFIC ON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE BOROUGH AND AT INTERSECTIONS THEREOF.

ARTICLE II  
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

§ 131-6. VEHICLES ON SIDEWALKS PROHIBITED.

NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR UPON ANY SIDEWALK IN THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH; NOR SHALL ANY PERSON OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE UPON OR ACROSS ANY SIDEWALK EXCEPT IN ORDER TO GAIN ACCESS TO OR EGRESS FROM A DRIVEWAY OR ALLEY AT SUCH LOCATIONS WHERE THE CURB, IF SUCH SIDEWALK IS CURBED, SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAT TEN (10) DAYS.

§ 131-7 SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED.

- A. A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED ON ALL STREETS AND ROADWAYS OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH AND IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO DRIVE A VEHICLE AT A HIGHER SPEED THAN THE MAXIMUM PRESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.
- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL OPERATE A VEHICLE AT A SPEED IN EXCESS OF THAT ESTABLISHED BY SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION UPON ANY STREET OR ROADWAY OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) AND THE COST OF PROSECUTION. ANY PERSON EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT BY MORE THAN FIVE (5) MILES PER HOUR OVER THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT. ANY PERSON CONVICTED UNDER THIS SECTION WHO DEFAULTS IN THE PAYMENT OF ANY FINES OR COSTS IMPOSED UNDER THIS

SECTION SHALL UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-8. TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS.

- A. AT THE FOLLOWING INTERSECTIONS, OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS SHALL BE ERECTED (OR IF HERETOFORE ERECTED ARE HEREBY RATIFIED), AND TRAFFIC AT SUCH INTERSECTIONS SHALL BE DIRECTED BY SUCH SIGNALS:

BRIDGE STREET AT EAST MAIN STREET  
EAST MAIN STREET CROSSING AT WASHINGTON AVENUE AND CHERRY ST.  
EAST MAIN STREET AT ENO STREET  
WEST MAIN STREET AT GAYLORD AVE. AND HANOVER STREET  
WEST MAIN STREET AT FLAT ROAD AND COAL STREET

- B. ANY OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR WHO SHALL DISOBEY THE DIRECTIONS OF ANY TRAFFIC SIGNAL SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THERE, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND, ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN THREE (3) DAYS.

§ 131-9. ONE WAY HIGHWAYS ESTABLISHED.

- A. THE FOLLOWING ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED AS ONE-WAY HIGHWAYS:

- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR UPON ANY HIGHWAY OR PORTION THEREOF HEREBY ESTABLISHED AS A ONE-WAY HIGHWAY OTHER THAN IN THE DIRECTION HEREBY ESTABLISHED FOR TRAFFIC THEREON SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-10. U-TURNS PROHIBITED ON PORTIONS OF CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

- A. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR TO MAKE A U-TURN ON ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PORTIONS OF HIGHWAYS:

(RESERVED)

- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-11. TURNS PROHIBITED AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS.

- A. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OPERATOR OF ANY VEHICLE OR TRACTOR TRAVELING UPON THE FIRST-NAMED HIGHWAY, IN THE DIRECTION OF DIRECTIONS HEREBY INDICATED IN EACH CASE, TO MAKE A LEFT TURN AND/OR RIGHT TURN AT THE FOLLOWING INTERSECTION, AS HEREBY INDICATED:

(RESERVED)

- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-12. TRAFFIC TO KEEP TO RIGHT OF STRUCTURES AND BARRIERS.

- A. ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC SHALL KEEP TO THE RIGHT OF THE FOLLOWING STRUCTURES OR BARRIERS LOCATED IN THE CENTER OF THE SPECIFIED INTERSECTIONS:

(RESERVED)

- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL OPERATE A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR IN VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT OF PAYMENT OF SUCH FINES AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.

§ 131-13. THROUGH HIGHWAYS ESTABLISHED.

- A. THE FOLLOWING HIGHWAYS ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED AS THROUGH HIGHWAYS, AND THE OPERATOR OF EVERY VEHICLE OR TRACTOR UPON APPROACHING ANY SUCH HIGHWAY AT ANY INTERSECTION THEREOF (EXCEPT FOR SUCH INTERSECTIONS WHERE THERE ARE NOW OR SHALL HEREAFTER BE LOCATED OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS) SHALL COME TO A FULL STOP, WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE, BEFORE ENTERING ANY SUCH THROUGH HIGHWAY:

(RESERVED)

- B. ANY OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR WHO SHALL FAIL TO COME TO A FULL STOP, WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE, BEFORE ENTERING ANY SUCH THROUGH HIGHWAY, AS HEREINABOVE REQUIRED, SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND, ON

DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN THREE (3) DAYS.

§ 131-14. STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED.

- A. THE FOLLOWING INTERSECTIONS (IN ADDITION TO HIGHWAYS ESTABLISHED BY § 131-13 OF THIS ARTICLE) ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED AS STOP INTERSECTIONS, AND OFFICIAL STOP SIGNS SHALL BE ERECTED (OR ARE HEREBY CONFIRMED IF HERETOFORE ERECTED) IN SUCH A POSITION AS TO FACE TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE SECOND-NAMED HIGHWAY UPON THE FIRST-NAMED HIGHWAY, IN THE DIRECTION OF DIRECTIONS HEREBY INDICATED. ALL VEHICLES AND TRACTORS APPROACHING ANY SUCH INTERSECTION UPON THE FIRST-NAMED HIGHWAY, IN THE DIRECTION OF DIRECTIONS HEREBY INDICATED IN EACH CASE, SHALL COME TO A FULL STOP, WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE, BEFORE ENTERING ANY SUCH INTERSECTION:

§ 131-15. YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED.

THE FOLLOWING INTERSECTIONS ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED AS YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY INTERSECTIONS, AND OFFICIAL YIELD SIGNS SHALL BE ERECTED (OR ARE HEREBY RATIFIED IF HERETOFORE ERECTED) IN SUCH A POSITION AS TO FACE TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE SECOND-NAMED HIGHWAY FROM THE FIRST-NAMED HIGHWAY, IN THE DIRECTION OR DIRECTIONS HEREBY INDICATED, SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANY VEHICLE IN THE INTERSECTION OR APPROACHING ON THE SECOND-NAMED HIGHWAY SO CLOSELY AS TO CONSTITUTE AN IMMEDIATE HAZARD DURING THE TIME THAT THE OPERATOR OF SUCH VEHICLE OR TRACTOR IS MOVING ACROSS OR WITHIN SUCH INTERSECTION:

(RESERVED)

- B. ANY OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR WHO SHALL FAIL TO YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AS HEREINABOVE REQUIRED SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF

PROSECUTION AND, ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN THREE (3) DAYS.

§ 131-16. CERTAIN CLASSES OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

- A. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO OPERATE ANY VEHICLE OR TRACTOR EXCEPT A PASSENGER VEHICLE (BUT NOT INCLUDING ANY PASSENGER VEHICLE DRAWING ANY TRAILER OR TOWING ANY OTHER VEHICLE) UPON ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PORTIONS OF THE HIGHWAYS IN THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH:

§ 131-21. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY FINE OF NOT LESS THAN TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND, ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH TO REPORT TO THE MAYOR ALL VIOLATIONS OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, INDICATING IN EACH CASE THE SECTION THEREOF, VIOLATED, THE LICENSE NUMBER OF THE VEHICLE INVOLVED IN SUCH VIOLATION, THE LOCATION WHERE SUCH VIOLATION TOOK PLACE, THE TIME OF SUCH VIOLATION AND ANY OTHER FACTS THAT MIGHT BE NECESSARY IN ORDER TO SECURE A CLEAR UNDERSTANDING OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES ATTENDING SUCH VIOLATION.

THE POLICE OFFICER MAKING SUCH REPORT SHALL ALSO ATTACH TO EVERY SUCH VEHICLE A NOTICE THAT SUCH VEHICLE WAS PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE, WHICH NOTICE SHALL CONTAIN INSTRUCTIONS TO THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF SUCH VEHICLE THAT IF HE SHALL REPORT TO THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH AND PAY, FOR THE USE OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH, THE SUM OF TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) WITHIN FIVE (5) DAYS AFTER THE TIME OF SUCH NOTICE, THE SAME SHALL SAVE SUCH VIOLATOR FROM PROSECUTION AND FROM PAYMENT OF THE FINE AND COSTS HEREINABOVE PRESCRIBED.

§ 131-21.1 HANDICAPPED PARKING

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL RECOGNIZING THE SPECIAL NEEDS OF HANDICAPPED PERSONS IN PLYMOUTH BOROUGH HEREBY ESTABLISHES A RESERVED PARKING PROGRAM WHICH WILL FACILITATE ACCESS TO AND FROM THE HANDICAPPED PERSON'S PLACE OF RESIDENCE.

## SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

AS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED, UNLESS A DIFFERENT MEANING CLEARLY APPEARS FROM THE CONTEXT:

HANDICAPPED PERSON; AN INDIVIDUAL POSSESSING A HANDICAPPED OR SEVERELY DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATE.

RESERVED PARKING SIGN; A SIGN ISSUED BY PLYMOUTH BOROUGH RESERVING PARKING FOR ONE (1) VEHICLE SPACE AND ERECTED AT A DESIGNATED AND AGREED UPON AREA FOR ACCESS FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

ISSUING AUTHORITY; PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

IN THIS ORDINANCE, THE SINGULAR SHALL INCLUDE THE PLURAL, THE PLURAL SHALL INCLUDE THE SINGULAR, AND MASCULINE SHALL INCLUDE THE FEMININE AND NEUTER.

## SECTION III. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH WILL PROMULGATE AND HAVE AVAILABLE APPLICATIONS FOR RESERVED PARKING SIGNS. SAID APPLICATIONS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE LOCATED IN THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 162 WEST SHAWNEE AVENUE, PLYMOUTH. ONCE THE APPLICATION HAS BEEN COMPLETED IT SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE FOR CONSIDERATION.

2. APPLICATION FEE- UPON SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY A FEE OF THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS TO PLYMOUTH BOROUGH. SAID APPLICATION FEE WILL BE NON REFUNDABLE TO COVER THE PROCESSING OF THE APPLICATION.

3. ALL APPROVED APPLICATIONS SHALL BE SUBJECTED TO ANNUAL REVIEW AND ARE SUBJECT TO REVOCATION FOR CAUSE. AT ANY REVIEW THE APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT A CURRENT WRITTEN STATEMENT FROM HIS/HER PHYSICIAN DESCRIBING THE DISABILITY AND THE ANTICIPATED DURATION OF THE DISABILITY.

4. APPLICATIONS MUST POSSESS A HANDICAPPED OR SEVERELY DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATE IN ORDER TO OBTAIN AN APPLICATION. ( OWNERS OF DISABLED VETERAN PLATES AS DISTINGUISHED FROM OWNERS

OR SEVERELY HANDICAPPED VETERAN'S PLATES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING SIGNS ).

5. APPLICATIONS ARE TO BE COMPLETED IN THEIR ENTIRETY. APPLICATIONS . APPLICATIONS NOT COMPLETED IN THEIR ENTIRETY WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

6. EACH APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT WITH THE COMPLETED APPLICATION A WRITTEN STATEMENT FROM HIS OR HER PHYSICIAN DESCRIBING THE DISABILITY AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE ANTICIPATED DURATION OF THE DISABILITY.

7. APPROVAL OR DENIAL OF APPLICATIONS WILL BE MADE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS BY THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE ( ISSUING AUTHORITY).

8. UPON APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF REQUISITE FEES THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH WILL ERECT TWO (2) RESERVED PARKING SIGNS WITH THE APPLICANT'S VEHICLE REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR USE BY THE APPLICANT.

9. THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE SHALL MAINTAIN A LOG OF ALL ALLOCATIONS FOR A RESERVED PARKING SIGN AND SHALL PERIODICALLY PROVIDE THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT A COPY THEREOF.

#### SECTION IV. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR OWNER OR REALTY TO ERECT A RESERVED PARKING SIGN OR HANDICAPPED PARKING SIGN UPON THE STREETS OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WITHOUT FIRST MAKING APPLICATION TO THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE. ANY PERSON WHO ERECTS OR UTILIZES A RESERVED PARKING SIGN OR A HANDICAPPED PARKING SIGN WHO HAS NOT FOLLOWED THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ORDINANCE IS SUBJECT TO PENALTIES SET FORTH HEREIN.

2. ANY STIPULATIONS MADE AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION REGARDING THE ELIGIBILITY OF AN APPLICANT MAY BE UPDATED PERIODICALLY AT THE REQUEST OF THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE.

3. RESERVED PARKING SIGNS SHALL NOT SUPERSEDE EXISTING PARKING REGULATIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO STREET SWEEPING SNOW BAN OR SNOW REMOVAL REGULATIONS.

4. RESERVED PARKING SIGNS WILL REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH.

5. PLYMOUTH BOROUGH SHALL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY IF AN ELIGIBLE PERSON NO LONGER QUALIFIES FOR A SIGN UNDER THIS ORDINANCE; FOR EXAMPLE, IF AN ELIGIBLE PERSON ENJOYS AN IMPROVED HEALTH CONDITION OR MOVES FROM THE PREMISES WHEREIN THE SIGN IS LOCATED. FAILURE TO NOTIFY PLYMOUTH BOROUGH CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

6. PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WILL TAKE THE FOLLOWING FACTORS INTO CONSIDERATION WHEN ISSUING RESERVED PARKING SIGNS.

(A). OVERALL AVAILABILITY OF PARKING IN THE AREA WHEREIN A SIGN IS REQUESTED SHALL BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION.

(B). THE LIVING ARRANGEMENTS OF AN INDIVIDUAL APPLICANT SHALL BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION; FOR EXAMPLE, A DISABLED PERSON LIVING ALONE AND RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS OR HER OWN TRANSPORTATION.

(C). EXISTING PARKING PROBLEMS IN THE AREA WHERE A SIGN IS REQUESTED.

7. THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY RESERVED PARKING SIGNS OR HANDICAPPED PARKING SIGNS FOR CAUSE SHOWN.

8. NO RESERVED PARKING SIGN WILL BE PLACED IN FRONT OF THE HOME OF A PERSON OTHER THAN THE APPLICANT UNLESS THAT PROPERTY OWNER SIGNS A NOTARIZED STATEMENT STATING THAT THEY HAVE NO OBJECTION TO THE PLACEMENT OF THE SIGN.

9. THE RESERVED PARKING AREA WILL BE DEFINED BY THE PLACEMENT OF TWO (2) RESERVED PARKING SIGNS. EACH RESERVED PARKING SIGN SHALL STATE THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER OF THE VEHICLE AUTHORIZED TO OCCUPY THE RESERVED PARKING SPACE.

#### SECTION V. PENALTIES

1. ANY PERSON WHO PARKS IN A RESERVED PARKING SPACE, WHO IS NOT AUTHORIZED TO DO SO SHALL BE SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE CITATION AND THE VEHICLE WILL BE SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE REMOVAL AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE, INCLUDING PAYMENT OF TOWING FEES AND ANY STORAGE OR IMPOUNDING FEES.

§131-24. HOURS AND DAYS OF OPERATION.

AFTER THE INSTALLATION OF SAID PARKING METERS, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE OR OTHER VEHICLE TO PARK SUCH VEHICLE FOR A LONGER PERIOD THAN THE MAXIMUM TIME INDICATED ON THE DIAL OF SAID PARKING METERS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 AM AND 6:00 PM ON ANY DAY OF THE WEEK EXCEPT SUNDAYS AND THE FOLLOWING HOLIDAYS: NEW YEAR'S DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY AND SEASONAL SHOPPING PERIODS WHICH THE CHIEF OF POLICE MAY DESIGNATE.

§ 131-25. DURATION OF LAWFUL PARKING PERIODS.

WHEN ANY VEHICLE SHALL BE PARKED IN ANY SPACE ADJACENT TO WHICH A PARKING METER IS LOCATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, THE OPERATOR THEREOF SHALL, UPON ENTERING SUCH PARKING SPACE DURING THE TIME OF LIMITED PARKING, IMMEDIATELY DEPOSIT A COIN OR COMBINATION OF COINS OF THE UNITED STATES IN SUCH PARKING METER AND OPERATE THE SAME ACCORDING TO INSTRUCTIONS THEREON. FAILURE TO DO SO SHALL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THE ARTICLE. UPON THE DEPOSIT OF TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (.25), TEN CENTS (.10) OR FIVE CENTS (.5) COINS AND PLACING THE METER IN OPERATION, THE PARKING SPACE MAY BE LAWFULLY OCCUPIED BY SUCH VEHICLE DURING THAT PERIOD OF PARKING TIME WHICH HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED FOR THE PARTICULAR AMOUNT DEPOSITED. THE PARKING METERS, WHEN



2. NO PERSON SHALL ERECT A RESERVED OR HANDICAPPED PARKING SIGN UPON THE STREET OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WITHOUT AUTHORITY UNDER THIS ORDINANCE FROM THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH TRAFFIC COMMITTEE.

3. ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, UPON SUMMARY CONVICTION THEREOF IN A SUMMARY PROCEEDING BEFORE A DISTRICT MAGISTRATE BE SUBJECT TO PAY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50.00 DOLLARS AND NOT MORE THAN \$200.00 AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION. IN ADDITION TO ANY FINE ABOVE AN ADDITIONAL \$50.00 FINE SHALL BE IMPOSED AS PROVIDED FOR PURSUANT TO 75 PA. C.S.A. SECTION 3354(G) OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MOTOR VEHICLE CODE, AS AMENDED.

#### SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE ARE SEVERABLE. IF ANY PART OF THIS ORDINANCE IS DECLARED TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL, ILLEGAL OR INVALID, THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINING PROVISIONS SHALL BE UNAFFECTED THEREBY. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL THAT THIS ORDINANCE WOULD HAVE BEEN ADOPTED HAD SUCH UNCONSTITUTIONAL, ILLEGAL OR INVALID PART NOT BEEN INCLUDED.

#### ARTICLE IV ON-STREET METERED PARKING

##### § 131-22. PARKING METER ZONES ESTABLISHED.

A. PARKING METER ZONES ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH EXCEPT FOR SUCH SPACES WITHIN SUCH PARKING METER ZONES WHERE PARKING IS NOW OR SHALL BE HEREAFTER BE PROHIBITED:

(1) W. MAIN ST. FROM GIRARD AVE.  
(BOTH SIDES)

(2) GIRARD AVE. FROM W. MAIN ST. TO  
EBENEZER CHURCH PARKING LOT

(3) CENTER AVE. FROM MAIN ST. TO  
DR. SAVAGE'S OFFICE

(4) ENO STREET FROM E. MAIN ST. TO



INSTALLED AND PROPERLY OPERATED, SHALL BE SO ADJUSTED THAT TWENTY-FIVE CENT, TEN CENT AND FIVE CENT COINS MAY BE DEPOSITED AT ANY TIME THROUGHOUT THE MAXIMUM RANGE OF THE METERS, PERMITTING THE VEHICLE TO BE PARKED. EACH FIVE CENT COIN PERMITTING THE VEHICLE TO BE PARKED FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) MINUTES AND EACH TEN CENT COIN PERMITTING THE VEHICLE TO BE PARKED FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) MINUTES AND EACH TWENTY-FIVE CENT COIN PERMITTING VEHICLE TO BE PARKED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE HOUR (1 HR). IF VEHICLE IS PARKED IN MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT LOCATED TO REAR OF COMMERCIAL LANE, A DEPOSIT OF TWENTY-FIVE CENTS WILL RESULT IN THE TIME OF TWO (2) HOURS. IF SUCH VEHICLE SHALL REMAIN PARKED IN ANY SUCH PARKING SPACE FOR SUCH LENGTH OF TIME THAT THE METER SHALL INDICATE BY PROPER SIGNAL THAT THE LAWFUL PARKING PERIOD HAS EXPIRED, SUCH VEHICLE SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS PARKING OVERTIME, AND THE PARKING OF A VEHICLE OVERTIME SHALL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE.

§ 131-26. VEHICLES TO WHOLLY WITHIN MARKED SPACES.

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO PARK ANY VEHICLE ACROSS ANY LINE OR MARKING DESIGNATING A PARKING SPACE OR TO PARK SAID VEHICLE IN ANY WAY THAT THE SAME SHALL NOT BE WHOLLY WITHIN A PARKING SPACE AS DESIGNATED BY SAID LINES OR MARKINGS.

§ 131-27. COINS SUBSTITUTES PROHIBITED.

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO DEPOSIT OR CAUSE TO BE DEPOSITED IN ANY PARKING METER A SLUG, DEVICE OR SUBSTITUTE FOR A COIN OF THE UNITED STATES.

§ 131-28. UNLAWFUL TO TAMPER WITH METER.

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO DEFACE, TAMPER WITH, DAMAGE, OPEN OR WILLFULLY BREAK, DESTROY OR IMPAIR THE USEFULNESS OF ANY PARKING METER INSTALLED UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS ARTICLE

§131-29. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT §131-28 THEREOF, SHALL, FOR EACH AND EVERY SUCH VIOLATION, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF,, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND, ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF §131-29 SHALL, FOR EACH AND EVERY SUCH VIOLATION, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) AND COST OF PROSECUTION AND, ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COST, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN TEN (10) DAYS.

ARTICLE V  
SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY  
STREET CLEANING

§ 131-30. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY.

IN ORDER TO FACILITATE THE MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC AND TO COMBAT THE HAZARDS OF EXCESSIVE SNOW AND ICE ON HIGHWAYS OR PORTIONS OF HIGHWAYS NAMED IN §131-33 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE MAYOR, IN HIS DISCRETION, MAY DECLARE AN EMERGENCY DUE TO SUCH HAZARDS.

§ 131-31. PARKING PROHIBITIONS AND OPERATION RESTRICTIONS.

AFTER ANY SUCH EMERGENCY SHALL HAVE BEEN DECLARED OR THE POSTING OF STREET CLEANING, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL DURING THE PERIOD OF SUCH EMERGENCY OR STREET CLEANING FOR ANY PERSON TO PARK A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR OR TO ALLOW THE SAME TO REMAIN PARKED ON ANY HIGHWAY OR PORTION THEREOF NAMED IN § 131-33 THIS ARTICLE, OR TO OPERATE ANY MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR ON ANY SUCH HIGHWAY OR PORTION THEREOF UNLESS SUCH VEHICLE OR TRACTOR SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH ADEQUATE EQUIPMENT TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT TRACTION TO KEEP SUCH VEHICLE OR TRACTOR IN MOTION SO THAT OTHER TRAFFIC ON SUCH HIGHWAYS WILL NOT BE BLOCKED OR SERIOUSLY IMPEDED OR TO ALLOW

SUCH VEHICLE TO BE PARKED IN POSTED ZONES OF STREET  
CLEANING WHICH WILL IMPEDED THE CLEANING OF ANY HIGHWAY  
OR PORTION THEREOF.

§131-32. PLACEMENT OF SIGNS; DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION.

- A. IN ORDER TO ASSIST THE OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
AND TRACTORS IN DETERMINING THE HIGHWAYS AFFECTED  
BY THIS ARTICLE, THE MAYOR OR CHIEF OF POLICE SHALL

§ 131-33 HIGHWAYS AFFECTED.

THE HIGHWAYS OR PORTIONS THEREOF TO WHICH THE  
PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE APPLICABLE DURING  
ALL PERIODS OF EMERGENCY OR STREET CLEANING

DECLARED AS PROVIDED IN §131-30 OF THIS ARTICLE ARE AS FOLLOWS:

§ 131-34. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

- A. AT ANY TIME DURING A PERIOD OF EMERGENCY DECLARED AS PROVIDED IN §131-30 OF THIS ARTICLE, ANY PERSON WHO SHALL PARK A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRACTOR ANYWHERE UPON OR ALONG ANY OF THE HIGHWAYS OR PORTIONS THEREOF LISTED IN §131-33 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE AND, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, SHALL BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION AND, ON THE FAULT OF PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COST, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS.
- B. ANY PERSON WHO SHALL OPERATE A VEHICLE OR TRACTOR UPON ANY HIGHWAY OR PORTION THEREOF LISTED IN §131-30 OF THIS ARTICLE AND SUCH STALLING SHALL HAVE BEEN BY REASON OF THE FAILURE TO HAVE SUCH VEHICLE OR TRACTOR EQUIPPED WITH THE EQUIPMENT HEREINABOVE PRESCRIBED, SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE, AND UPON CONVICTION THEREOF SUCH PERSON SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AND COSTS OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN TEN (10) DAYS.

§131-36. RECEIPT OF NOTICE; PAYMENT OF FINE.

- A. ANY PERSON COMMITTING ANY OF THE OFFENSES INDICATED ABOVE MAY, UPON RECEIPT OF A NOTICE OF VIOLATION INDICATING THE OFFENSE AND THE AMOUNT OF THE FINE, APPEAR AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WITHIN FIVE (5) DAYS OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND PAY THE AMOUNT OF THE FINE INDICATED. SUCH PAYMENT SHALL BE THE EQUIVALENT OF A PLEA OF GUILTY AND SHALL SAVE THE VIOLATOR FROM PROSECUTION AND THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS THEREOF.

## ARTICLE VII

### INTERPRETATION AND REPEAL

#### §131-38 PROVISIONS TO BE CONTINUATIONS OF EXISTING REGULATIONS

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER, SO FAR AS THEY ARE THE SAME AS THOSE OF ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS IN FORCE IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE ENACTMENT OF THIS CHAPTER, ARE INTENDED AS A CONTINUATION OF SUCH ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS AND NOT AS NEW ENACTMENT'S. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL NOT AFFECT ANY ACT DONE OR LIABILITY INCURRED, NOR SHALL THEY AFFECT ANY SUIT OF PROSECUTION PENDING OR TO BE INSTITUTED TO ENFORCE ANY OF THESE REPEALED ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS. AT ANY TIME, ALL FINES AND PENALTIES PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE ALTERED OR AMENDED BY A RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL.

#### §131-39 SEVERABILITY.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE SEVERABLE, AND, IF ANY OF ITS PROVISIONS SHALL BE HELD TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL, ILLEGAL OR OTHERWISE INVALID, SUCH DECISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF ANY OF THE REMAINING PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER. IT IS HEREBY DECLARED AS A LEGISLATIVE INTENT THAT THIS CHAPTER WOULD HAVE BEEN ADOPTED HAD SUCH UNCONSTITUTIONAL, ILLEGAL OR OTHERWISE INVALID PROVISION NOT BEEN INCLUDED HEREIN.

§131-40. REPEAL OF CERTAIN PRIOR ORDINANCES.

## ARTICLE VIII

### PARKING AND STORAGE OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES SCHOOL BUSES AND TRUCK TRACTORS

§131-41. DEFINITIONS.

AS USED IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED:  
REFER TO ORDINANCE NO. 11 OF 1992: ORDINANCE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH, LUZERNE COUNTY COMMONWEALTH OF  
PENNSYLVANIA, PARKING AND STORAGE OF COMMERCIAL  
VEHICLES, SCHOOL BUSES AND TRUCK TRACTORS.

§131-42. STORAGE IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS RESTRICTED.

NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLE WITH A GROSS WEIGHT  
EXCEEDING EIGHT THOUSAND (8,000) POUNDS OR WITH MORE THAN  
TWO (2) AXLES NOR ANY TRUCK TRACTOR OR SCHOOL BUS, AS  
DEFINED IN §131-41 ABOVE, SHALL BE STORED, PARKED OR  
OTHERWISE KEPT IN ANY AREA CLASSIFIED AS AN R1, R2, OR R3  
DISTRICT, AS DEFINED IN THE ZONING ORDINANCE IN EFFECT IN  
THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH.

§131-43. EXCEPTIONS.

THE RESTRICTIONS SET FOR IN §131-42 ABOVE SHALL NOT  
APPLY TO THE FOLLOWING:

(A) ANY RECREATION MOTOR VEHICLE, CAMPER,  
TENT, TRAILER OR SIMILAR VEHICLE.

(B) VEHICLES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PLYMOUTH

(C) FIRE APPARATUS

(D) AMBULANCES

(E) VEHICLES ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR OF STREETS OR WHILE ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN MAKING DELIVERIES OR RENDERING SERVICES IN OR UPON ANY PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN R-1, R-2 OR R-3 DISTRICT.

(F) ANY SCHOOL BUS ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN PICKING UP OR DISCHARGING STUDENTS BUT ONLY FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NECESSARY TO SAFELY PICK UP AND DISCHARGE STUDENTS.

§131-44. SCHOOL BUSES.

IN ADDITION TO THE RESTRICTIONS SET FORTH IN §131-42 ABOVE, NO SCHOOL BUS SHALL BE PARKED ON ANY STREET WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH AT ANY TIME EXCEPT AS IS NECESSARY TO SAFELY PICK UP OR DISCHARGE PASSENGERS.

§131-45. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

ANY PERSON OR PERSONS, FIRMS, OR CORPORATIONS VIOLATING ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, UPON SUMMARY CONVICTION THEREOF, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH SUCH VIOLATION AND COST OF PROSECUTION, AND ON DEFAULT IN PAYMENT OF SUCH FINE AND COSTS, TO UNDERGO IMPRISONMENT .
