

ORDINANCE NO. 9 of 2016

A ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF LUZERNE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE ELECTED COUNCIL AND MAYOR PURSUANT TO 8 Pa.C.S.A § 1001(e) and 10A04(a) and (b) FOR THE TERM COMMENCING IN JANUARY 2018 AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Borough Code, specifically 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 1001(e) the Council can fix the compensation for members by Ordinance at the beginning of the next term of the member of council;

WHEREAS, municipal elections will be held in 2017 to elect some members of council who's term will commence the first Monday of January, 2018;

WHEREAS, in order achieve savings in the operation of the Borough, council has decided that in order to do so it would reduce its compensation starting with the next term as required by the laws governing the same;

WHEREAS, Council has the authority by Ordinance to fix the compensation for the Mayor which will become effective the next term of the Mayor in accordance with 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 10A04 (a) and (b) and the election for the next term of the Mayor will be held in 2017, with the term commencing the first Monday in January 2018;

WHEREAS, the council based upon the authority stated above as well as the reason, feels that the compensation for Councilman and the Mayor elected in 2017 for the terms commencing in 2018 and thereafter shall be compensated at the annual rate of \$1.00 per year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Plymouth Borough Council pursuant to the authority vested in them by virtue of 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 1001(e) and 8 Pa.C.S.A. § 10A04 (a) and (b) and in accordance with Article III, Section 27 of the Pennsylvania Constitution hereby fix the compensation for all Councilman and the Mayor elected in 2017 and thereafter and any appointments made to fill a vacancy in office of a Councilman or Mayor elected in 2017 and thereafter, to be compensated for the performance of their respective duties at the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per year for their entire term of office. This rate of compensation will commence the first Monday of January of 2018 and govern the compensation for Councilman and the Mayor, whose term commences on the first Monday of January 2018 and thereafter and shall remain the same until changed according to law.

The preamble stated above is incorporated herein by reference thereto.


This Ordinance consisting of two pages, which includes the signature page, shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Borough Code, specifically, 8 Pa.C.S.A. §3301.3.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Resolved and adopted at a regular monthly meeting this 13th day of December 2016.

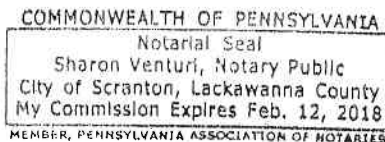
