

RESOLUTION NO. 1 OF 2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH
OF PLYMOUTH, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH CIVIL SERVICE
COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Plymouth Borough previously adopted by motion Rules and Regulations for the Civil Service Commission on January 14, 2014;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid rules were amended by Resolution 1 of 2014 on March 11, 2014 by the Council and again by Resolution 19 of 2016 on November 15, 2016;

WHEREAS, the Boroughs after operating under said rules finds a need to update the same to meet its current needs, the Council is amending portions of § 4 and § 5 of the aforementioned Rules that were previously adopted as herein after stated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED by the Borough Council of Plymouth, that § 4 Applications and qualifications, subparagraph D. is amended to read as follows: D. Age and residency requirements. Each applicant must have reached his/her 18th birthday before the deadline for submitting completed applications. § 5 Examination and grading procedure, subparagraph H. Examination for entry-level police positions. (1) The examination for the position of police officer shall consist of the following parts: Step 2 Agility test Pass/ fail Pass/fail is eliminated from this provision in its entirety; § 5 Examination and grading procedure, subparagraph L. (regarding Ineligibility for future exams) is eliminated in its entirety. The current rules shall be updated to reflect these amendments immediately. Except for the specific items referred to herein above, the previous rules and regulations adopted shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.

Any resolution or any part thereof conflicting with this resolution is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
