## RESOLUTION # 12 of 2015

A Resolution for the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) 2015 Single Application for Local Share Account (Luzerne County) Gaming Funds for Borough building renovations and safety conditions of the Borough Building, Council Chambers, Administrative Offices and Plymouth Borough Police Department to be submitted to the DCED.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Plymouth authorizes <u>Barbara Fairchild</u>, <u>Borough Manager</u> as it's designee to execute documents pertaining to Borough of Plymouth's DCED single application for request for gaming funds for upgrades and renovations for improvements of the Plymouth Borough Building, Police Department for energy efficiency and security, etc.
