**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH
OF PLYMOUTH, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF
COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FROM ITS STRATEGIC
MANAGEMENT PLANNING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Plymouth Borough wishes to submit an application to the Department of Community and Economic Development's Strategic Management Planning Program to conduct an overall evaluation of the Borough's finances and operations;

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic development makes available grants-in-aid to such projects through the Strategic Management Planning Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED by the Borough Council of Plymouth, Borough of Plymouth, Luzerne County hereby authorizes Plymouth Borough Council to make application for such a grant on behalf of the Plymouth Borough to conduct an overall evaluation of the Borough's finances and operations.

Be it further resolved, that Plymouth Borough does hereby designate the President of Council as the official to execute all documents and agreements in order to make application for such a grant and the Borough Secretary to attest to his signature when necessary.


It is further resolved that Plymouth Borough hereby allocates local resources in the amount of Eighteen Thousand (\$18,000.00) dollars as its local share to said project.

Adopted at a regular meeting of the Plymouth Borough Council held on this 11th day of February, 2020.


