

**RESOLUTION NO. 6A OF 2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH, LUZERNE COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FILLING THE VACANCY IN COUNCIL OCCURRING DUE TO  
RESIGNATION OF COUNCILMAN GARY KOCHINSKI**

**WHEREAS,** Gary Kochinski, a truly dedicated public servant, served Plymouth Borough as a Councilman;

**WHEREAS,** Gary Kochinski, whose term expires on January 1, 2022, tendered his resignation from Council which was accepted by Council, with regret, at a regular meeting August 14, 2018, thereby, creating a vacancy on the Plymouth Borough Council;

**WHEREAS,** Section 901 of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 901 authorizes the Borough Council to fill such a vacancy within thirty (30) days thereof, by appointing by Resolution, a registered elector of the Borough to hold such office, until his term expires on January 1, 2022;

**WHEREAS,** Section 901 of the Borough Code requires that the person appointed to fill such a vacancy be a registered elector of the Borough and have resided continuously in the Borough for at least one (1) year immediately prior to being appointed to fill the vacancy;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Plymouth Borough Council that due to the resignation of Gary Kochinski, which was effective on August 14, 2018 when Council accepted the same at a regular meeting, Council hereby declares that the seat held by Councilman, Gary Kochinski, is vacant for the remainder of his term, which expires on the first Monday in January of 2022. In conformity with the authority, dictates and requirements of Section 901 of the Borough Code, Council does hereby appoint Alexis Gosh, a registered elector of Plymouth Borough, who has resided within the Borough for at least one (1) year immediately prior to this appointment to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Gary Kochinski and to serve as a member of Plymouth Borough Council effective immediately until the first Monday in January, 2022.

The person appointed above shall give bond if required by law or any Ordinance of the Borough.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption by council.
