RESOLUTION NO. 6A OF 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FILLING THE VACANCY IN COUNCIL OCCURRING DUE TO RESIGNATION OF COUNCILMAN GARY KOCHINSKI

WHEREAS, Gary Kochinski, a truly dedicated public servant, served Plymouth Borough as a Councilman;

WHEREAS, Gary Kochinski, whose term expires on January 1, 2022, tendered his resignation from Council which was accepted by Council, with regret, at a regular meeting August 14, 2018, thereby, creating a vacancy on the Plymouth Borough Council;

WHEREAS, Section 901 of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 901 authorizes the Borough Council to fill such a vacancy within thirty (30) days thereof, by appointing by Resolution, a registered elector of the Borough to hold such office, until his term expires on January 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, Section 901 of the Borough Code requires that the person appointed to fill such a vacancy be a registered elector of the Borough and have resided continuously in the Borough for at least one (1) year immediately prior to being appointed to fill the vacancy;

The person appointed above shall give bond if required by law or any Ordinance of the Borough.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption by council.
