**AGENDA VOTING:**

A motion was made to approve Resolution 5 of 2023:

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER ACT 71, LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT (LSA) TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AGENCY OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR REPLACE TO THE ROOF AND THE HVAC SYSTEM AT THE PLYMOUTH PUBLIC LIBRARY, 107 W MAIN STREET, PLYMOUTH, PA. THE GRANT IS FOR \$178,780.00 AND MUST BE SUBMITTED BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.

Mr. Kobusky said the borough would commit \$75,000.00 towards the cost of the library projects.

A motion was made to approve Resolution 6 of 2023:

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF PLYMOUTH BOROUGH, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER ACT 71, LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT (LSA) TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AGENCY TO ACQUIRE FUNDS TO HIRE AN ENGINEER TO DRAW UP PLANS FOR THE MAIN STREET MASTER PLAN FOR COMPLETE STREET SCAPING. GRANT IS FOR \$100,000.00. AND MUST BE SUBMITTED BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.

\*On the question: Mr. Thomas asked if the borough would be matching funds for this grant?

Mr. Kobusky stated No, that there were no matching funds for this grant. The purpose of the grant was to hire an engineer to draw up plans for a 3 phase

downtown streetscape which would include sidewalks, curbs, crosswalks, tree lawns, decorative street lighting and ADA accessibility. He further stated that this would open possibilities of applying for other grants such as multimodal, CDBG, etc.
